Open to Amateurs who are members of any club affiliated to the Norfolk County Golf Union (active handicap limit 4), and are eligible to play in the Norfolk Amateur Championship (see Regulation 2.8), those who qualified for the final day of the 2011 Norfolk Amateur Championship and Professionals and Assistant Professionals who are attached to such Clubs and/or are members of the Norfolk PGA.

The Norfolk Professional Championship will be played concurrently: the winner will become the holder of the Trafford Cup. The Union will present prizes for Professionals.

Amateurs will receive prizes for the best aggregate scores.

Ties for the Championship will be decided by 'sudden death' play off; for the Amateur aggregate prizes on the last 18, 9, 6 or 3 holes.

The decision of the Committee in all matters relating to the Competition shall be final.

All competitors are reminded that this is a 36 hole competition and they are expected to complete both rounds. Anyone failing to do so without an acceptable reason could be subject to disciplinary action.
