will be decided on the last 18, 9, 6 or 3 holes.

ENTRANTS MUST BE OVER 55 YEARS OF AGE ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION

HANDICAP LIMIT 18 at any time during the period for entries above. **All handicaps must be active.** Entries may be limited at the discretion of the Committee. If entries exceed the limit, players with higher exact handicaps will be eliminated, by ballot if necessary

Other conditions as to qualification are as for the County Amateur Championship and can be obtained from the Competitor's Club Secretary. These conditions are shown in Regulation 2.8 in the County Union Handbook.

Ties for the Championship will be decided by 'sudden death' play off; for other prizes on the last 9, 6, or 3 holes.

The decision of the Committee in all matters relating to this Competition shall be final.

All competitors are reminded that they are required to complete the full 18 holes. Anyone failing to do so without an acceptable reason could be subject to disciplinary action
